Today, ENA is announcing it will extend the ENPC and TNCC verification to Aug. 31, 2020, for providers whose status was set to expire between May 31-July 31 of this year. This extension will also include those providers previously set to expire in March and April who were previously extended to May 31.

You do not have to do anything as the new date will automatically appear in your profile. As before, instructor requirements, including instructor candidates effected during this time frame will also be extended.

As the COVID-19 pandemic unfolds, ENA will remain engaged with you to understand your needs. We continue to monitor this situation and will be fluid in responding to your concerns.
