Drive—Thru Clinic Instructions

What to expect at the drive-thru clinic for scheduled vaccines

- ◆ Be prepared to wait. There may be people in line ahead of you.
- ◆ Please wear a short sleeve shirt. The vaccine will be administered into your upper arm.
- ◆ Only those with scheduled appointments will receive a vaccination.
- ◆ If you do not qualify for the current phase (Phase-1a or 70 years of age and older), you will be asked to come back when you are eligible to receive the vaccination.
 - Healthcare workers included in Phase-1a will be asked to present proof of eligibility (i.e. current ID badge, paystub, medical license or letter of eligibility on company letterhead signed by your supervisor).
- ◆ There is no fee for the vaccination, but we will request permission to bill your insurance.
- ◆ Each person will receive a fact sheet for the Emergency Use Authorization and information on what to do if you experience any side effects.
- ◆ Your second dose appointment will be scheduled for the drive-thru clinic on Monday, February 15 at the Florence Center.
- ◆ To comply with federal and state privacy laws, audio and video recording are not permitted on the premises.
 - Please do not take pictures of staff, volunteers or others being vaccinated

Follow the instructions below to help move the line as quickly as possible

- ◆ Bring an ID to verify your identity and age, if you have one.
- ◆ Be seated next to a window that rolls down in your vehicle.
- ◆ When you arrive, stay in your vehicle.
 - Staff will be available to guide you through the line and to receive the vaccination from your vehicle.
- ◆ Please arrive wearing a facemask that covers the nose and mouth.
- ◆ Do not bring pets in the vehicle.
- ◆ Upon arrival, individuals will be asked to complete a pre-vaccination questionnaire to determine if there is any reason an individual should not get the COVID-19 vaccine.
- ◆ Individuals who are currently under COVID-19 isolation (tested positive within the last 10 days) or quarantine orders (identified as a close contact within the last 14 days) should wait until their isolation/quarantine period is over to be vaccinated.

After you receive your vaccination

- ◆ After you receive your vaccine, you will be instructed to drive to another parking lot to wait 15 minutes to self-monitor for any possible post-vaccine reactions.
 - If you begin experiencing any symptoms, turn on your vehicle's flashers/blinkers.
 - EMS is on-site and will immediately respond to your vehicle.
- ◆ You should not receive any other vaccinations until 14 days after you have received your second dose.
