MUSC TELESTROKE ALGORITHM

Hemodynamically stable?

Step 1 Follow your Step 2 Local physician to assess hospital's Determine Last Known patient and calculate NIHSS protocol Normal (LKN =the last time the patient was known to be in their normal state) **Pathway Factors** Send to CT, call MUSC ATC, Thrombectomy • LKN < 4.5 hours then register in platform LKN 4.5 - 24 hours and Send to CT, call MUSC ATC, NIHSS ≥ 6 and/or Aphasia* then register in platform Collaboration Physician • LKN > 24 hours or Obtain CT, then call MUSC unknown and NIHSS ≥ 6 ATC for Physician to Physician and/or Aphasia* telephone consult

Stroke Symptoms

- Sudden onset of focal weakness, or paralysis of the face, arm, or leg
- Sudden onset of difficulty speaking, understanding spoken word (Aphasia)*

Follow your hospital's protocol

- Sudden onset of difficulty seeing out of one eye or both eyes
- Sudden onset of weakness/dizziness with ataxia, loss of balance or coordination
